SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER JAMES SINGER ON THE
15th DAY OF JANUARY, 1996.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE TO PURCHASE DETAILED CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR YANKEE TRACE DRIVE IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, proposals were prepared by Bayer Becker Engineers for the preparation of detailed construction plans for Yankee Trace Drive from Social Row Road north for approximately 2200 lineal feet, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Centerville to purchase the detailed construction plans for said improvement from Great Traditions Development Group as requested by the City Engineer consisting of a cover sheet, plan and profile sheets for the roadway, sanitary sewer lines, storm drainage lines, and water main; intersection details; grading plan; erosion control plan; drainage maps; drainage calculations; estimated quantities and as-built drawings for the water and sanitary sewer improvements; and

WHEREAS, the cost of said detailed construction plans for that portion of Yankee Trace Drive amounts to \$36,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase detailed construction plans prepared by Bayer Becker Engineers for the Yankee Drive improvements from Great Traditions Development Group in an amount not to exceed \$36,000.00.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
