A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE CD '96
CELEBRATION OF THE 200TH ANNIVERSARY OF OUR
AREA IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CENTERVILLE-
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP BICENTENNIAL AND TO
RECOGNIZE SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS LOCAL
GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC SERVANTS HAVE MADE
OVER THE PAST 200 YEARS.

WHEREAS, on March 21, 1796 a group of restless settlers traveled up the Great
Miami River to settle their homes on a new land that soon would become known as Dayton; and


WHEREAS, in February, 1796 Aaron Nutt, Benjamin Robbins and Benjamin
Archer completed a survey of a vast green sea of forest inhabited by wild animals and occasional
bands of roving Indians north of Cincinnati in which they settled to become known as Centerville
and Washington Township, and

WHEREAS, over the past 200 years the citizens of these regions have served and
sacrificed to help these tiny settlements grow and prosper, contributing to the health and well
being of the state, nation and world.

RESOLVES:


SECTION 1. That the City of Centerville, in cooperation with CD '96 and the
