A RESOLUTION DECLARING SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT  
NO LONGER UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF  
CENTERVILLE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF  
SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
THE GUIDELINES AS STATED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville desires to maintain  
adequate police equipment to be utilized by its personnel, and


WHEREAS, equipment no longer needed for use by City  
police personnel may be declared as surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY  
RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That four .223 caliber automatic Ruger  
rifles and three cases of ammunition are hereby declared as  
surplus property, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and  
directed to offer for sale and/or trade said equipment to another  
law enforcement agency.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective at  
the earliest date allowed by law.
