A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, TO COOPERATE WITH WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP AS THE LEAD AGENCY FOR THE SPRING VALLEY ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Board of Trustees advertised for bidders for the Spring Valley Road Improvement Project in the unincorporated area of Washington Township and the incorporated area of the City of Centerville, and

WHEREAS, the low and best bid submitted by the John R. Jurgensen Company is being accepted by Washington Township, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Centerville to cooperate with the Washington Township Board of Trustees in this joint improvement project, the estimated cost to the City of Centerville being \$721,819.90 with the understanding that this total cost will be paid jointly by the Ohio Public Works Commission and the City of Centerville.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of Centerville, to cooperate with the Washington Township Board of Trustees as the lead agency for the Spring Valley Road Improvement Project and to do all things necessary to cause payment pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
