A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID FROM L.P. CAVETT COMPANY FOR THE 1996 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CONCRETE REPAIR AND ASPHALT RESURFACING FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT IN CONNECTION HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville advertised for bidders for the 1996 Road Improvement Project, Concrete Repair and Asphalt Resurfacing pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and

WHEREAS, L.P. Cavett Company was the low and best bidder.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by L.P. Cavett Company marked Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby accepted in the total amount of \$514,357.50, and that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any necessary agreement to evidence acceptance of said bid and to make payment pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to expend up to a total amount of \$520,000.00 in accordance with unit prices quoted in the bid submitted by the L.P. Cavett Company for additional repairs as deemed necessary.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
