WHEREAS, in 1990 the City of Centerville purchased real estate along Yankee Road for the purpose of developing a golf course, and a clubhouse for residents of our Community to enjoy, and

WHEREAS, in 1994 a contract was executed with Joe Becks and Associates for the construction of the clubhouse at The Golf Club at Yankee Trace, and


WHEREAS, in order to better identify the restaurant/banquet facility, located within the clubhouse, the Council of the City of Centerville determined that the restaurant/banquet facility shall be known as "The Gallery at Yankee Trace".

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE  
HEREBY RESOLVES:


