A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE JOHN R. JURGENSEN COMPANY FOR THE 1995 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CONCRETE REPAIR AND ASPHALT RESURFACING, IN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for the 1995 Road Improvement Project, Concrete Repair and Asphalt Resurfacing, in the City of Centerville, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and

WHEREAS, the John R. Jurgensen Company was the low and best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the bid submitted by the John R. Jurgensen Company marked Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby accepted in the amount of \$494,160.87, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any necessary contract to evidence acceptance of said bid and to make payment pursuant thereto.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to expend up to a total amount of \$550,000.00 in accordance with unit prices quoted in the bid submitted by the John R. Jurgensen Company for additional repairs as deemed necessary.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
