A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MISSION OF THE
MIAMI VALLEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
COALITION AS PART OF A COMPREHENSIVE REGIONAL
PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, it is imperative that we continue to recognize inventions,
innovations and technologies which are characteristic of the Miami Valley Region, and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Miami Valley Economic Development Coalition is
to focus the efforts of the Miami Valley community leadership on key economic development
initiatives to create a competitive advantage in one or more high potential growth areas for the
Miami Valley, and

WHEREAS, it is important that the Miami Valley Economic Development
Coalition work cooperatively and in concert with the Regional Economic Strategies Forum and
the I-70/75 Development Association to achieve its stated mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the City of Centerville supports the mission of the Miami
Valley Economic Development Coalition as complimentary to the missions of the Regional
Economic Strategies Forum and the I-70/75 Development Association and as part of a
comprehensive regional program to cause our economic growth to continue to improve the
standard of living for all citizens of the region.
