A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PARTICIPATE IN A CONTRACT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OFFICE OF STATE PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO PICK UP TRUCKS AND RELATED MATERIAL FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-88.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 19-88, passed by the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, on the 16th day of January, 1989, authorized the City of Centerville to participate in contracts of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials, and


WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into a contract with 32 Ford Mercury, Inc., Batavia, Ohio, for the purchase of certain equipment and supplies, in accordance with Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES;

Section 1. That the City Manager be authorized to participate in a contract between the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing and 32 Ford Mercury, Inc., Batavia, Ohio, for the purchase of two (2) Ford F-150 Pick up trucks, one (1) Parts book, and one (1) Shop manual, for the purchase price of \$26,941.00 and to directly pay the vendor, under state contract.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
