A RESOLUTION OF COOPERATIVE SUPPORT

WHEREAS, as elected officials of the City of Centerville, Washington Township and the Centerville Board of Education, we are concerned about the availability of illegal drugs and alcohol to youth in our community, and

WHEREAS, our purpose is twofold: first, we want to stress to our youth that we care about their well being and safety and therefore we will not tolerate possession or use of illegal drugs or alcohol, and


WHEREAS, second, we ask parents and community members to join us in a renewed effort to eliminate illegal drugs in our community and prohibit the use of alcohol by minors.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

Section 1. We pledge as civic leaders to coordinate efforts among city government, township government and the board of education to act to eliminate the possession and use of illegal drugs and alcohol by the youth of our community.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
