NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the council of the City ofCenterville
SECTION 1. (COOPERATION)
The public interest demands the improvement, under the provisions of Chapter 5521 Ohio revised Code, of that part of Interstate Route No. 675, situated in the County of Montgomery, State of Ohio, and described as follows:
Tree planting on interstate 675 between State Route 48 and Wilmington Pike.
SECTION 2. (CONSENT)
The City does hereby propose to cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the said improvement as follows:
 pay to the Department of Transportation the amount of \$20,000.00 for a total estimated project cost of \$40,000.00.
2) oversee the awarded contractor once work commences.
 submit a report after work is completed, stating inspection dates and any other pertinent information relating to this project.
4) maintain the trees in an accepted manner for 3 years after installati
SECTION 3. (AUTHORITY TO SIGN)
The <u>City Manager</u> is hereby empowered and directed on behalf of the City to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the planning and construction of this improvement.
