SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER J.V. Stone ON THE
4th DAY OF April, 1994.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A FEE SCHEDULE ON
THE GENERATION OF SOLID WASTES WITHIN THE
MONTGOMERY COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT
DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 153 provides solid waste districts
a funding source for the implementation of waste reduction and
recycling programs set forth in solid waste management plans, and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Policy Committee's
Financial Sub-committee recognized that full implementation of
the recycling programs presented in the District's Solid Waste
Management Plan would be in jeopardy if additional funding was
not available, and


WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Policy Committee of
the Montgomery County Solid Waste Management District established
a \$1.00 per ton fee on the generation of solid waste within the
District for the purpose of helping to fund the implementation of
the District's Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:


SECTION 1. That the City of Centerville hereby
approves the \$1.00 per ton fee on the generation of solid waste
within the Montgomery County Solid Waste Management District as
established by the Solid Waste Management Policy Committee for
the purpose of helping to fund the implementation of the
District's Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council of the City of
Centerville is hereby directed to forward a copy of this
Resolution to the Solid Waste Management Policy Committee of the
Montgomery County Solid Waste Management District.


