

RESOLUTION NO. 42-94

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Mark Beesley ON
THE 20th DAY OF June, 1994.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO COOPERATE WITH WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP AS THE
LEAD AGENCY FOR A JOINT APPLICATION FOR ISSUE
2 OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT FUNDS
(LTIP) FOR THE SPRING VALLEY ROAD
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, voters of Ohio passed Issue 2 authorizing the
State of Ohio to issue bonds for the purpose of financing or
assisting local governments in financing Public Infrastructure
Capital Improvements, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Centerville to
support Washington Township as the lead agency in a joint
application for State Issue 2 Funds or Local Transportation
Improvement Funds for Public Infrastructure Capital Improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and
directed to cooperate with Washington Township as the lead agency
for a joint application with appropriate signatures for Capital
Improvement Projects as defined in Section 164.01(A) of the Ohio
Revised Code and H.B. 704 and to provide such information as may
be requested by the District 4 Public Works Integrating
Committee, or by the State Commission Director or Administrators.

SECTION 2. The City of Centerville hereby commits the
local share of the grant and to any costs exceeding the estimate
of the application to improve Spring Valley Road within the
corporate limits of the City of Centerville in cooperation with
Washington Township.


SECTION 3. The City of Centerville will voluntarily
contribute to the District 4 Public Works Integrating Committee,
up to one percent (1%) of funded project estimates, loans or
credit enhancement.

SECTION 4. The City of Centerville recognizes that
project cost overruns may not be funded by the District 4
Committee.

SECTION 5. The City of Centerville commits to the reporting requirements contained in Section III of the Standing Rules of the District 4 Committee.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
