A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE MOUND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND THE MOUND ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY CENTER (MATC) IN THE CONTINUING TRANSITION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY'S MOUND FACILITY FROM PUBLIC SECTOR TO PRIVATE SECTOR USE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miamisburg, the Mound Reuse Committee, and the Mound Community Improvement Corporation, have organized and developed programs to successfully transition the Mound facility from public sector to private sector use; and

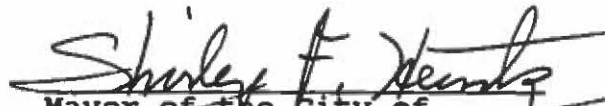
WHEREAS, the success of these economic re-development, reuse, and commercialization programs not only are key to the livelihood and well-being of our region, but also our community of Centerville; and
