

RESOLUTION NO. 14-93

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER J. V. Stone ON THE
15th DAY OF March, 1993.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OFFICE OF STATE PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR MARKED PATROL CARS AND TWO UNMARKED POLICE VEHICLES FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-88.

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for the purchase of four marked patrol cars and two unmarked police vehicles for the City of Centerville, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 19-88, passed by the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, on the 16th day of January, 1989, authorized the City of Centerville to participate in contracts of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials, and


WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into a contract with 32 Ford Mercury, Inc., Batavia, Ohio, for the purchase of Ford Crown Victorias with the police package.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The City Manager be authorized to enter into an agreement with the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchase for the purchase of four marked patrol cars and two unmarked police vehicles from 32 Ford Mercury, Inc., and to directly pay the vendor, under state contract.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
