SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Sally Beels ON THE
2nd DAY OF August, 1993.

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE LEADERSHIP
ROLE OF THE CITY OF MIAMISBURG IN THE
TRANSITION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY'S
MOUND FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the Department of Energy has announced the
decommissioning of its Mound facility located in Miamisburg,
Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the people who have worked at this site have,
for over 40 years, managed their stewardship of the local
environment faithfully and effectively for the protection of all
citizens; and

WHEREAS, the employees of Mound have been actively
involved in the improvement of the quality of life in our
communities, schools, major social programs, and made significant
contributions to the technical resources of our region and the
State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Mound employees have contributed to the
defense of our country and its way of life; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miamisburg has assumed a
leadership role in attempting to save the technological and human
resources which exist at the facility; and

WHEREAS, the facility is located within the city limits
of the City of Miamisburg; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville as a part of the
Greater Dayton Community and a stakeholder wishes to be
supportive of the City of Miamisburg's efforts and acknowledges
the City's leadership role in the transition of the facility and
the creation of the "Partnership".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:


SECTION 1. The City of Centerville does hereby express
it's support of the Partnership and the City of Miamisburg in the
transition efforts to reuse, redevelop and commercialize the
Mound Facility's buildings, equipment and property and to protect
the technical and human resources at the Mound.

SECTION 2. The City of Centerville does hereby recognize the City of Miamisburg's leadership role in forming the Partnership and in representing the interests of the community to the Department of Energy on transition activities at the Mound.

SECTION 3. The City of Centerville also hereby expresses its support for the legislative proposals by Representative Tony Hall which proposes the transfer of buildings, equipment and property to the City for economic development purposes; and by Senator Glenn which is designated to allow Mound to perform CRADA (Technology transfer) work. These legislative proposals are designed to assist the City in the transition process.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.


