A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A PROPOSAL FROM RICK STUM, STUM MASONRY, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR SERVICES NECESSARY IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CONCESSION STAND AND RESTROOM FACILITY IN THE LEONARD E. STUBBS MEMORIAL PARK.

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 26-92 the City of Centerville, Ohio, was authorized to act as its own General Contractor in the construction of a concession stand and restroom facility at the Leonard E. Stubbs Memorial Park in the City of Centerville, and

WHEREAS, Rick Stum, Stum Masnory has submitted a proposal for services necessary to complete the construction of said concession stand and restroom facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to accept a proposal from Rick Stum, Stum Masonry for said services; proposal which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

RE: Stubbs Park Concession Restroom building

REQUIREMENTS OF MASONRY CONTRACTOR:

1. Perform all masonry work from slab up specified on plans provided by Woolpert Consultants and dated 5/29/92, Revision 1 dated 8/7/92; Revision 2 dated 8/24/92; Revision 3 dated 7/2/93. Furnish all labor, tools, equipment, insurance, and consumables.
2. Set all door Jams. Making sure they are square, level and plum.
3. Install all block flashing, lintels, and re-barb specified on plans.
4. Work with plumber and electricians as needed.
5. The plans refer to colored block. There is no colored block in building. All block will be painted.

Note: The plans show only the first and sixth course being split face. This has been changed to courses one thru five being split face block. Course six and up will be standard block.

6. Keep work site clean at all times during his work.

7. Final cleanup of any debris from his craft on site.

Total Cost to be: Sixteen Thousand Two Hundred (\$ 16,200.00)
