SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER J. V. Stone ON THE
7th DAY OF September, 1993.

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION TAKEN
BY THE CITY MANAGER TO REMIT TO THE
MONTGOMERY COUNTY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT
THE SUM OF \$42,773.08 FOR WATER AND SEWER
CONNECTION FEES IN CONNECTION WITH THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE YANKEE TRACE GOLF
COURSE/RESIDENTIAL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the sum of \$42,773.08 was required to be paid
to the Montgomery County Engineering Department for water and
sewer special connection fees associated with 30.772 acres of the
Yankee Trace Golf Course/Residential development proposed on the
site of the Yankee Trace Clubhouse and Maintenance Building
facilities, and

WHEREAS, it was necessary that this payment be made in
advance of the presentation of the waterline extension project by
the Montgomery County Engineering Department to the Montgomery
County, Board of County Commissioners on September 7, 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the action taken by the City Manager
is hereby ratified to remit to the Montgomery County Engineering
Department the sum of \$42,773.08 for water and sewer connection
fees associated with 30.772 acres of the Yankee Trace Golf
Course/Residential development proposed on the site of the Yankee
Trace Clubhouse and Maintenance Building facilities.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective at
the earliest date allowed by law.
