SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Sally Beels ON THE  
20th DAY OF September, 1993.

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ISSUE 1 TO  
PROTECT PARKS AND NATURAL RESOURCES IN THE  
STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1993, Ohio voters will be asked to support a \$200 million issue for the improvement of Ohio's state and local parks systems, and

WHEREAS, Issue 1 will make available, initially, \$40 million for local parks creating a permanent, dedicated source of revenue for the many parks around the state which need to have their facilities updated and repaired on a regular basis, and

WHEREAS, Issue I will help both local governments and the state create very needed revenue to protect and improve parks, forests, recreation areas, and natural resources without an increase in taxes.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Centerville supports Issue 1, which extends an opportunity to the electorate to protect the important investments that have already been made and to make available additional revenue to update and maintain state and local parks and natural resources without an increase in taxes.


SECTION 2. That the Clerk of the Council of the City of Centerville shall cause a copy of this Resolution to be delivered to the Ohio Municipal League, 175 South Third Street, Suite 510, Columbus, Ohio 43215-7100.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
