CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Mark Beebe ON THE
18th DAY OF October, 1993.

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE DAYTON/
SPRINGFIELD I/M POLICY COMMITTEE'S
REQUEST TO IMPLEMENT ENHANCED INSPECTION
AND MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, the Counties of Clark, Greene, Miami and
Montgomery are designated as moderate nonattainment for National
Ambient Air Quality Standard for ozone; and

WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 require
that any nonattainment area must develop a Compliance Plan which
commits to the implementation of emission control strategies to
reduce volatile organic compound emissions by at least 15% by the
year 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 require
that nonattainment areas must implement a Vehicle Inspection and
Maintenance program; and

WHEREAS, if Basic Inspection and Maintenance is
implemented in the counties of Clark, Greene, and Montgomery
instead of Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance, additional
emission controls will be required to account for the difference
in emission reductions; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Amended Senate Bill 18 (Inspection and
Maintenance Bill) provides for a local opt-in process to
implement Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance programs; and

WHEREAS, an Inspection and Maintenance (I/M) Policy
Committee, consisting of members of the Clark County-Springfield
Transportation Coordinating Committee and the Miami Valley
Regional Planning Commission Transportation Committee, was formed
in compliance with Amended Senate Bill 18, to request the
Director of Ohio EPA to implement an Enhanced Inspection and
Maintenance Program in the Counties of Clark, Greene and
Montgomery; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the local opt-in process of
Amended Senate Bill 18, the I/M Policy Committee approved a
Resolution of Intent to include Enhanced Inspection and
Maintenance in its Compliance Plan, because it achieves greater
emission reductions and is more cost effective than the basic
program; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the local opt-in process of Amended Senate Bill 18, the I/M Policy Committee conducted public meetings in each of the four counties; and

WHEREAS, public comments received during the public meetings were considered by the I/M Policy Committee in its final deliberations on the opt-in to Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the I/M Policy Committee has passed a resolution to formally request the Director of Ohio EPA to implement and supervise an Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance program for the counties of Clark, Greene and Montgomery; and


WHEREAS, the I/M Policy Committee is asking the City of Centerville to approve the Resolution to Request Implementation of Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


SECTION 1. That the City of Centerville approves the I/M Policy Committee's Resolution to Request Implementation of Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance.

SECTION 2. This Resolution becomes effective immediately upon passage.


