SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER J. V. Stone ON
THE 20th DAY OF January 1992.

A RESOLUTION NAMING THE PROPOSED GOLF
COURSE TO BE CONSTRUCTED BY THE CITY OF
CENTERVILLE "YANKEE TRACE".

WHEREAS, in 1990 the City of Centerville purchased
real estate along Yankee Road for the purpose of developing a
golf course for residents of our Community to enjoy, and

WHEREAS, an Agreement has been executed between the
City of Centerville and Gene Bates and Associates, Inc. to
undertake planning, golf course design, and engineering
services in connection with the City's golf course project,
and

WHEREAS, in order to better identify the golf course
owned by the City of Centerville, City Council has determined
that the golf course shall be known as "Yankee Trace".

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE
HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the City owned golf course to be
developed along Yankee Road shall from this date forward be
known as "Yankee Trace".

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective
at the earliest date allowed by law.
