
WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for two marked police cruisers and one utility vehicle for the City of Centerville, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and

MARKED POLICE AUTOMOBILE SPECIFICATIONS

Exhibit "A"

The following are specifications for vehicles to be used by the Centerville Police Department as "marked" patrol cars. It is the purpose of these specifications to describe a vehicle to be used in Law Enforcement work. The vehicle will be operated for long periods of time at normal traffic speeds, with frequent periods of idling; however, the vehicle must also be capable of fast acceleration and high speed performance. For this reason the vehicle must have an outstanding cooling system, braking system and handling characteristics.

The manufacturer, in the selection and engineering of components, will use materials and design practices that will produce the best vehicle in the industry for the type of operation to which the vehicle is to be subject. Component parts and design shall be of the quality that will give maximum performance, durability and safety, and not merely meet minimum requirements of this specification.

The vehicle in all respects shall meet or exceed all requirements of the Federal Government and the State for the model year bid. The vehicle shall include all standard equipment normally sold and marketed to the retail public, unless specifically deleted by request.

15. EXTERIOR COLOR: Two tone; car "Hawaiian Blue" (Dupont Centari #6820A or PPG #14340) with four white stripes, two on either side of the vehicle, design to be specified by the City and painted in accordance with automotive standards. Painted by dealer to your specifications.
16. UPHOLSTERY: Vinyl/cloth front seats; vinyl on rear bench seat. Included
