THE 21st DAY OF December, 1992.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A REQUEST TO THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION (MVRPC) FOR FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAY FUNDS TO BE PROGRAMMED FOR THE REPAIR AND RESURFACING OF CLYO ROAD FROM ALEXANDERSVILLE-BELLBROOK ROAD NORTH AND EASTWARD TO BIGGER ROAD.

WHEREAS, existing Clyo Road from Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road to Bigger Road is in need of repair and resurfacing, and

WHEREAS, the repair and resurfacing of Clyo Road from Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road to Bigger Road is eligible for Federal-Aid Highway funding, and

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) by the Governor acting through the Ohio Department of Transportation in cooperation with locally elected officials for Greene, Miami and Montgomery Counties, and

WHEREAS, the MVRPC's Transportation Committee serves as the policy and decision making body through which local governments guide the MPO's transportation planning process.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit a request to the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission for Federal-Aid Highway Funds to be programmed for the repair and resurfacing of Clyo Road from Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road north and eastward to Bigger Road.

SECTION 2. The City of Centerville commits the non-federal, local funds for the engineering phase and the construction phase of the above Clyo Road repair and resurfacing project.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
