
A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ENFORCEMENT
AND EDUCATION FUND.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


SECTION 1. There is hereby established an enforcement and education fund which shall be the depository to receive payments from the Kettering Municipal Court from fines for offenses resulting from violations of Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.19 or the corresponding Centerville Ordinance which fund is established pursuant to Section 4511.99, Ohio Revised Code. The purpose of said fund shall be to pay costs related to DARE programs and the enforcement and education relating to the D.U.I. laws of the City.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to take any and every step necessary to carry out the purpose of this Resolution and to make disbursements from said fund as provided for herein.
