A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE OF  
COOPERATION BETWEEN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE  
AND WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the local governments of Washington  
Township and the City of Centerville provide services to  
their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the area served by these two entities is  
commonly referred to as the Centerville-Washington Township  
community; and

WHEREAS, the two jurisdictions have worked  
effectively on various common projects in the past; and

WHEREAS, the elected officials of both entities  
hope to create an improved mechanism for ongoing cooperation.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE  
HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. A Committee of Cooperation be hereby  
formed and furthermore that said Committee be composed of a  
Township Trustee as appointed by the Board of Trustees, the  
Mayor of the City of Centerville, the Centerville City  
Manager and the Washington Township Administrator.

SECTION 2. The purpose of the Committee shall be  
to provide a continuing forum whereby leaders of both  
communities can meet, regularly communicate, and propose  
action on important mutual government issues.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective  
at the earliest date allowed by law.
