A RESOLUTION NAMING THE CITY PROPERTY
LOCATED AT 166 NORTH MAIN STREET IN THE
CITY OF CENTERVILLE "BENHAM'S GROVE".

Main Street in the City of Centerville was purchased by
Joseph P. Benham, and

WHEREAS, Joseph Benham, a bachelor, served with the
131st National Guard at Fort Federal Hill in Baltimore during
the Civil War, and became a prominent merchant in
Centerville, and


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville on

HEREBY RESOLVES:


SECTION 1. That the City owned property located at
