

SPECIFICATIONS FOR
SELF PROPELLED LITTER VACUUM

INTENT It is the intent of this specification to describe a riding type, self propelled litter vacuum suitable for use in Parks, and on/off paved areas, with the following minimum specifications considered necessary to perform the work assigned.

GENERAL TERMS All equipment furnished under this contract shall be new, unused, and of current production. Accessories not specifically mentioned herein, but necessary to furnish a complete unit ready for use, shall also be included along with any accessory or feature mentioned in current literature.

The apparent silence of this specification and any supplemental specifications as to any details or the omission from it of a detailed description concerning any point shall be regarded as meaning that only the best commercial practices are to prevail. All interpretations of this specification shall be made upon the basis of this statement. The buyer reserves the right to waive or take exception to these specifications if it be to the buyer's advantage or best interest.

PAYMENT FOR THE UNIT WILL BE CONTINGENT UPON DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE COMPLETED UNIT BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

The following are minimum requirements. Bidders are cautioned to state actual specifications in area provided. Do not use check marks or "complies" for this purpose. Any exception to specification not so stated shall be cause for bid disqualification. Bid must be returned on original request form or facsimile.
