

RESOLUTION NO. 32-90

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCIL MEMBER SALLY BEALS
ON THE 17TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1990

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT IT WOULD BE INAPPROPRIATE AND A WASTE OF TAXPAYERS' MONEY TO SECURE COMPETITIVE PUBLIC BIDDING ON THE PURCHASE OF A FORD NEW HOLLAND LEAF LOADER FOR THE REASON THAT THERE IS ONLY A SINGLE SUPPLIER OF SAID EQUIPMENT WHICH CAN MEET THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the purchase of major items of equipment by the City is normally the result of competitive public bidding pursuant to Chapter 105 of the Centerville Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, there are occasions when such competitive bidding is wasteful of time and money because there is only one source which can reasonably supply equipment desired by the City which meets the City's specifications; and


WHEREAS, it is determined by the Council that in such situations compliance with Chapter 105 would not be in the best interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, the city manager has made a determination that the purchase of a Ford New Holland Leaf Loader can be made from only one source which meet the City's specifications and that source is Mid-State Power Equipment, Inc. which has quoted a purchase price of \$ 25,884;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY HEREBY RESOLVES:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Mid-State Power Equipment, Inc. to purchase a Ford New Holland Leaf Loader for a purchase price of \$ 25,884 and to cause payment to be made therefor.
