

RESOLUTION NO. 13-89

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER James Singer ON THE
20th DAY OF March 1989.

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING CITY COUNCIL SUPPORT FOR THE PROPOSAL TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO DEVELOP A STRATEGIC PLAN TO ATTRACT, RETAIN AND EXPAND AEROSPACE AND ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY IN SOUTHWESTERN OHIO; AND AUTHORIZING THE COMMITMENT OF \$500 TOWARDS THAT EFFORT.

WHEREAS, the federal government through the Stevenson-Wydler Act, the Technology Transfer Act of 1986, and the Presidential Order on Science and Technology has given local military leaders the authority and direction to accelerate technology transfer to industry and local governments; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has demonstrated an interest in supporting and cooperating with existing federal installations and academic institutions to expand research and development efforts in the area of aerospace and advanced technology; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has recognized the immense technological and economic resources of Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, major academic institutions and the private sector, and the potential opportunities these resources present to create new jobs and position the region as a premier center for aerospace and advanced technology; and

WHEREAS, the various chambers of commerce, together with the Dayton Area Technology Network, the Miami Valley Research Institute, Ohio Senator Charles F. Horn, area legislators, and others are soliciting the political and financial support of the local governments in the Miami Valley for the creation of a Regional Economic Development plan to attract, retain and expand aerospace and advanced technology industries in southwestern Ohio and the state, by emphasizing the academic, research, technological and economic resources at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base.

NOW THEREFORE

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT

SECTION 1. The City of Centerville recognizes the importance of a comprehensive strategy for retaining and increasing the presence of aerospace and advanced technology industries, and the benefits such economic development provides to the city and the region.


SECTION 2. The City of Centerville joins with other local governments in support of the regional efforts to establish an Economic Development Task Force on Aerospace and Advanced Technology to develop such a strategy and hereby commits \$500 toward that effort.

SECTION 3. The City Council strongly urges the Governor of Ohio, the Ohio General Assembly, and the Ohio Department of Development to support the foregoing efforts in the best interest of economic development in southwest Ohio and the state.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby directs the Clerk of the Council to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Governor of Ohio, the members of the Ohio General Assembly, and the Director of the Ohio Department of Development.

SECTION 5. This resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.


