

RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-88
CITY OF CENTERVILLE

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Jeffrey Siler ON
THE 14th DAY OF March, 1988

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A LEKTRIEVER
FILE SYSTEM FOR THE SUM OF \$15,524.00 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
BIDDING.

WHEREAS, The City had determined that it would be in
the best interest of the City to replace the filing system for
the police department; and

WHEREAS, it was initially determined that a non-
electrical mechanical system was available which would satisfy
the City's needs; that said system was cheaper; that said system
had a longer lifespan; that said system was simpler to operate
and easier to maintain and that the needs could be furnished for
approximately \$8,000.00 which is below the competitive bidding
level of the City established by ordinance of \$14,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the bid was awarded for the installation of
such system for \$7,999.95; and

WHEREAS, once said system installation commenced it was
determined that the system was deficient in the following
respects even though it fully met specifications: the system
takes more than twice the floor space presently occupied by the
police departments filing system; it is aesthetically displeasing;
the filing on the lower shelves requires a user to get down on
hands and knees; the filing on the upper shelves requires one to
climb up onto something or remove an entire tray of drawers above
the head level which is physically difficult and dangerous; there
is no work space for the dispatchers and it is apparent that the
system was intended for an operation smaller than that required
by the Centerville Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Remco the supplier is willing to accept the
return of the system it proposed to supply, grant a full refund
of the purchase price and supply a new system for \$15,524.00
which would mean an additional payment by the City in the amount
of \$7,524.05; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that said replacement
would be in the best interest of this City and that competitive
bidding therefore is not in the best interest of the City because
the only way the best interests of the City can be served is by
dealing with the original supplier.


NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


