There is hereby established a Law Enforcement Fund which shall be the depository to receive contraband forfeiture moneys pursuant to Section 2933.43, Ohio Revised Code. The purpose of said fund shall be to pay the cost of protracted or complex investigations, training, to provide matching funds for federal grants and the cost of other activities as specified or permitted by Section 2933.43, Ohio Revised Code or as subsequently authorized by this Council.

The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to take any and every step necessary to carry out the purpose of this resolution and to make disbursements from said fund as provided for herein.
