## RESOLUTION REQUESTING FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY MAXIMUM MATURITY OF BONDS

WHEREAS, this Council proposes to issue bonds in the principal amount of \$207,350 for the purpose of discharging at maturity (together with cash payments of special assessment and other lawfully available funds) a bond anticipation note issued to pay part of the cost of improving Clyo Road in the City of Centerville, from Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road in a northeasterly direction approximately 3650 feet to connect with the existing Clyo Road extension west of Bigger Road, by grading, draining, curbing, paving, installing sidewalks, constructing a storm water drainage system, and installing water mains and facilities and appurtenances, and paying other lawful costs incident to the issuance of said bonds, or notes issued in anticipation thereof; now, therefore,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Finance, as fiscal officer, be and is hereby requested to certify to this council the estimated life of the improvements to be constructed with the proceeds of the sale of the bonds referred to in the preamble hereof, and the maximum maturity of such bonds, as

provided in Sections 133.20, 133.21, 133.32 and 133.35 of the Ohio Revised Code.
