A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID TdM CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., FOR 1986 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.


