

RESOLUTION NO. 4-84

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Jeffrey Siler ON THE 19th DAY OF March, 1984.

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING AN ADVANCE OF EIGHTY THOUSAND (\$80,000.00) DOLLARS OUT OF THE CURRENT COLLECTION OF REAL ESTATE TAXES ASSESSED AND COLLECTED ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Auditor of Montgomery County, Ohio is hereby requested to issue his warrant upon the Montgomery County Treasurer in favor of the City of Centerville for Eighty Thousand (\$80,000.00) Dollars, of the current collection of real estate taxes assessed and collected for and on behalf of the City of Centerville, which sum shall be held and treated as an advance payment on the current collection of taxes due the City of Centerville on the date next ensuing after the date of this resolution. Fifty-Five Thousand (\$55,000.00) Dollars shall be allocated to the General Fund, Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars shall be allocated to the Police Levy Operating Fund, and Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars shall be allocated to the General (Unvoted) Bond Retirement Fund.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to accept said warrant on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
