CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Charles Texter ON THE 16TH DAY OF APRIL, 1984

RESOLUTION REQUESTING FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY MAXIMUM MATURITY OF BONDS AND NOTES

WHEREAS, this Council proposes to issue bonds in the principal amount of \$230,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing and improving sidewalks, curbs and gutters, and constructing, resurfacing, grading or drainage of various roads, highways, streets and alleys in the City of Centerville, Ohio, and paying other lawful costs incident to the issuance of said bonds, or notes issued in anticipation thereof, and proposes to issue notes in anticipation of such bonds in the principal amount of \$230,000; and

WHEREAS, \$560,000 of bond anticipation notes issued for such purpose mature on May 2, 1984, and should be paid at maturity with the proceeds of sale of the bond anticipation notes described above, together with other lawfully available funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

officer, be and is hereby requested to certify to this council the estimated life of the improvements to be constructed with the proceeds of the sale of the bonds referred to in the preamble hereof, the maximum maturity of such bonds, and the maximum maturity of notes to be issued in anticipation of such

bonds, as provided in Sections 133.20, 133.21, 133.32 and 133.35 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
