A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 32-83 AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ALLOCATION OF INCOME TAX RECEIPTS AMONG THE GENERAL FUND, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND, DEBT RETIREMENT FUND, STREET CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE FUND, THE CENTRAL VEHICLE PURCHASE FUND AND THE EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR THE REMAINDER OF BUDGET YEAR 1984.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 32-83 is hereby amended as follows:

From all municipal income tax receipts by the City, the following allocation is hereby to be made between the General Fund, Capital Improvements Fund, Debt Retirement Fund, Street Construction and Maintenance Fund, the Central Vehicle Purchase Fund, and the Equipment Reserve Fund.

To the General Fund - [fifteen and nine tenths (15.9) percent] seventy-one and one tenth (71.1) percent,

To the Capital Improvements Fund - [forty-six and four tenths (46.4) percent] one and no tenths (1.0) percent,

To the Debt Retirement Fund - [thirty-seven and seven tenths (37.7) percent] zero (0.0) percent,

To the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund - eight and five tenths (8.5) percent,


To the Central Vehicle Purchase Fund - twelve and one tenth (12.1) percent,

To the Equipment Reserve Fund - seven and three tenths (7.3) percent.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary action in order to carry out the allocations provided for herein.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective as of May 1, 1984.
