## RESOLUTION NO. 21-93 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 39-82 AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ALLOCATION OF INCOME TAX RECEIPTS AMONG THE GENERAL FUND, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND, DEBT RETIREMENT FUND, STREET CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE FUND, THE CENTRAL VEHICLE PURCHASE FUND AND THE EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR THE REMAINDER OF BUDGET YEAR 1983.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 39-82 is hereby amended as follows:

From all municipal income tax receipts by the City, the following allocation is hereby to be made between the General Fund, Capital Improvements Fund, Debt Retirement Fund, Street Construction and Maintenance, [and] the Central Vehicle Purchase Fund, and the Equipment Reserve Fund.

To the General Fund - [thirty-nine and six tenths (39.6) percent] sixty-two and seven tenths (62.7) percent,

To the Capital Improvements Fund - [sixteen and eight tenths (16.8) percent] seven and nine tenths (7.9) percent,

To the Debt Retirement Fund - [thirty-three and six tenths (33.6) percent] four and four tenths (4.4) percent,

To the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund [ten (10.0) percent] eighteen and eight tenths (18.8) percent.

To the Central Vehicle Purchase Fund - one and five tenths (1.5) percent.

To the Equipment Reserve Fund - four and seven tenths (4.7) percent.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary action in order to carry out the allocations provided for herein.
