

RESOLUTION NO. 34-83  
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN James Singer ON THE 19th DAY  
OF December, 1983.

A RESOLUTION ALERTING THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION OF A POTENTIAL DANGEROUS SITUATION IN THE  
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, AND THAT THE OHIO DEPARTMENT  
OF TRANSPORTATION UNDERTAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO  
ALLEVIATE SAID SITUATION.

WHEREAS, the proposed construction of Interstate Route 675 in the  
City of Centerville, Ohio, has the potential of restricting the flow in  
certain drainage structures in the Village South area, and

WHEREAS, such restriction of the free flow of surface water might  
seriously aggravate existing drainage and flooding problems, and

WHEREAS, this concern has been repeatedly expressed by a concerned  
citizens' group and by members of City Council.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the Department of Transportation, State of Ohio,  
be alerted to the potential dangerous situation, and that the Ohio Department  
of Transportation undertake any steps necessary to alleviate the potential  
flooding of low-lying areas in Centerville which might be affected by the  
construction of Interstate Route 675.
