A RESOLUTION REQUESTING AN ADVANCE OF SIXTY THOUSAND (\$60,000.00) DOLLARS OUT OF THE CURRENT COLLECTION OF TAXES ASSESSED AND COLLECTED ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Auditor of Montgomery County, Ohio is hereby requested to issue his warrant upon the Montgomery County Treasurer in favor of the City of Centerville for Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) Dollars, of the current collection of taxes assessed and collected for and on behalf of the City of Centerville, which sum shall be held and treated as an advance payment on the current collection of taxes due the City of Centerville on the date next ensuing after the date of this resolution. Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars shall be allocated to the General Fund and Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars shall be allocated to the Police Levy Operating Fund.


Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to accept said warrant on behalf of the City.
