

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to



THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between the City of Centerville (hereinafter "Centerville"), and the Board of Health of the Montgomery County, Ohio, Combined General Health District, (hereinafter "Board of Health") under the following circumstances:

WHEREAS, a Board of Health and the legislative authority of a city may contract for the provision of health services pursuant to O.R.C. 3709.281, and

WHEREAS, Centerville desires to have the Board of Health furnish certain public health services within the corporate limits of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties that:

1. The Board of Health, through its agents, is hereby authorized to conduct a public health program in and render public health services to the City of Centerville. Such health programs and services shall be substantially equivalent to the programs and services performed elsewhere in Montgomery County by the Board of Health.

2. In consideration of the provision of such public health services by the Board of Health, Centerville shall pay to the Board of Health the sum of Forty-One Thousand Two-Hundred Ten Dollars (\$41,210), plus the amount of reimbursements received from the State Treasurer and commonly known as the state subsidy to local public health; office supplies; office facilities; and other considerations as mutually agreed. (Attachment A).

3. The Board of Health shall periodically submit to Centerville a statement of services in carrying-out the provisions of the Agreement.

4. This Agreement shall be in effect from January 1, 1981 through December 31, 1981. This Agreement may be terminated with six (6) months written notice.

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between the City of Centerville (hereinafter "Centerville"), and the Board of Health of the Montgomery County, Ohio, Combined General Health District, (hereinafter "Board of Health") under the following circumstances:

WHEREAS, a Board of Health and the legislative authority of a city may contract for the provision of health services pursuant to O.R.C. 3709.281, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health and the City of Dayton are desirous of implementing a staff development and in-service training program which will enhance the overall effect of service delivery to the residents of the Health District.

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton's contribution, is \$10,000, but conditional to a one to one (1:1) match in new monies in grants, gifts or contributions from other political subdivisions.

WHEREAS, Centerville desires to share in the cost of implementing a staff development and in-service training program.

NOW, THEREFORE, It is agreed between the parties that the City of Centerville shall pay Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) as its pro-rated share for the cost of this program, and

This Agreement shall be in effect from January 1, 1981, through December 31, 1981.

- A G R E E M E N T -

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between the City of Centerville, Ohio (hereinafter "Centerville"), and the Board of Health of the Montgomery County, Ohio, Combined General Health District, (hereinafter "Board of Health") under the following circumstances:

WHEREAS, a Board of Health and the legislative authority of a city may contract for the provision of health services pursuant to O.R.C. 3709.281, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health, the City of Dayton and the United Way are desirous of maintaining a service known as the Dayton Free Clinic and Counseling Service, (hereinafter "Free Clinic") which provides counseling and referral services to youths between the ages of thirteen and nineteen, and

WHEREAS, Centerville desires to share in the cost of maintaining the Free Clinic.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties that:

1. The Board of Health hereby agrees to operate and maintain the Free Clinic for so long as the present budget will permit.

2. In consideration of the continued operation and maintenance of the Free Clinic, Centerville shall pay Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) as its pro-rated share for the cost of this service.

3. The Board of Health shall periodically submit to Centerville a statement of services incurred in carrying-out the provisions of this Agreement.

4. This Agreement shall be in effect from January 1, 1981 through December 31, 1981. This Agreement may be terminated with six (6) months written notice.
