SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Russell Sweetman ON THE 6th
DAY OF April, 1981.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING, ENDORSING, AND SUPPORTING
A GRANT REQUEST OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR A
LITTER CONTROL AND RECYCLING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, litter is unsightly and unsanitary, and

WHEREAS, millions of dollars are spent in Ohio each year to
remove litter from along roads, streets, waterways, recreational places,
and other public areas; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville recognizes the
existence of a litter problem within the boundaries of Centerville and the
need to address the problem, at the local level; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Litter Control Act of 1980 provides, through
the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Litter Control, for the
allocation of public funds in the form of grants for the purpose of
enhancing local litter control programs; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed our application for a grant under this
program and having considered the guidelines covering the administration
and use of such grant funds;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE:

HEREBY endorses, and supports a litter control program for the
City of Centerville, and can provide the necessary funds to implement said
program as indicated in the accompanying application; and


HEREBY authorizes the City Manager to apply for, budget and
