RESOLUTION REQUESTING FISCAL OFFICER TO
CERTIFY MAXIMUM MATURITY OF BONDS AND NOTES


WHEREAS, this Council proposes to issue bonds in the principal amount of \$48,100 for the purpose of paying at maturity, together with other lawfully available funds, a bond anticipation note heretofore issued for the purpose of paying the cost of acquiring a 1980 refuse packer truck and radio, and proposes to issue notes in anticipation of such bonds in the principal amount of \$48,100;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Finance, as fiscal officer, be and is hereby requested to certify to this council the estimated life of the improvements to be constructed with the proceeds of the sale of the bonds referred to in the preamble hereof, the maximum maturity of such bonds, and the maximum maturity of notes to be issued in anticipation of such bonds, as provided in Sections 133.20, 133.21, 133.32 and 133.35 of the Ohio Revised Code.




