

RESOLUTION NO. 35-81

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Shirley Heintz ON THE 31st
DAY OF August, 1981.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE TO PARTICIPATE WITH THE CITY OF WATERLOO, ONTARIO, CANADA IN THE SISTER CITY PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Centerville to participate in the Sister City Program which has been instituted nationwide to improve international relations by fostering the bringing together of citizens of cities in the United States with citizens from cities in foreign countries; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Centerville hereby determines that participation in said Program by the City of Centerville is a valid municipal purpose and a benefit to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Waterloo, Ontario, Canada, has been considered for designation as a sister city of the City of Centerville, Ohio; and


WHEREAS, citizens of Waterloo, Ontario, Canada are scheduled to visit with citizens of the City of Centerville, Ohio and to participate in activities with them; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville deems it appropriate and a valid municipal purpose to expend public funds in said endeavor; now, therefore,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager and the Director of Finance are hereby authorized and directed to expend up to One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars of municipal funds for the purposes set forth hereinabove.


