

RESOLUTION NO. 40-81

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Charles G. Taylor, Jr. ON THE 2nd DAY OF November, 1981.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT CONCERNING ESTABLISHMENT OF A REHABILITATION PROGRAM FOR THE PREVENTION OF ALCOHOLISM AND FOR THE TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION OF ALCOHOLICS AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF FEES.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville recognizes that alcoholism is a major problem facing society today; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Combined General Health District proposed to enter into an Agreement with the City of Centerville to establish a professionally staffed, progressive rehabilitation program for prevention of alcoholism and for the treatment and rehabilitation of alcoholics; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville deems it advisable to participate in such a program and to enter into an Agreement with the Montgomery County Combined General Health District concerning such a program to contribute 10 percent of the funds received by the City of Centerville from the State of Ohio for record permit fees toward the payment for such a program;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with the Montgomery County Combined General Health District for the establishment of a program for the prevention of alcoholism for the treatment of rehabilitation of alcoholics, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto, marked Exhibit A and incorporated herein.


SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make any and all payments called for in accordance with the Agreement attached hereto as exhibit A and the said Director of Finance and City Manager are further authorized and directed to do any and all necessary things in order to carry out the terms of said Agreement.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.



A G R E E M E N T

10% LIQUOR PERMIT FEES FOR ALCOHOLISM

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this _____ day of _____, 19____, by and between the MONTGOMERY COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT (the "Health District") and the CITY OF CENTERVILLE ("Centerville").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of the Parties to this Agreement that a professionally staffed, progressive rehabilitation program be implemented, operated and maintained for the prevention of alcoholism and for the treatment and rehabilitation of alcoholics, and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Body of the City of Centerville has by resolution declared its intention of cooperating with the Health District and other political subdivisions within Montgomery County, Ohio, in the establishment and operation of a program against alcoholism;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual promises, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The City of Centerville shall contribute to the Health District ten percent (10%) of the funds received by it from the State of Ohio for Liquor Permit Fees for the year 1981 for the implementation, operation and maintenance of a program for the prevention of alcoholism and for the treatment and rehabilitation of alcoholics.

2. The City of Centerville shall pay such funds to the Health District within thirty (30) days from the date upon which this Agreement becomes effective, or thirty (30) days after the receipt of such funds from the State of Ohio.

3. The Health District agrees to administer such program through its Director of the Bureau of Alcoholism Services. A report outlining the history, operation, services and goals of the program shall be provided to the City of Centerville in accordance with the Health District's report system. The parties hereto further agree that the administration and operation of the program shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Health District.

4. The Health District agrees that any funds provided under this Agreement which are not expended in the program or otherwise encumbered in the calendar year in which such funds were contributed, shall remain in an escrow fund for future expenditure in the program and shall not revert to the general fund of the Health District. In the event such program shall be discontinued, unused funds shall be returned to the City of Centerville; provided, however, any rights, title and interests of or in files, furnishings, equipment, and other property, either real or personal, which was acquired in whole or in part from funds provided under this Agreement, shall remain with the Health District.

5. This Agreement applies to returned Liquor Permit fees for the year 1981.
