A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT FOR THE YEAR 1980.

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into Contracts for health services with the Montgomery County Combined General Health District, a copy of which Contracts are attached hereto, marked Exhibits "A", "B", "C" and "D" and incorporated herein, for the year 1980 and to expend the sums therein stipulated.

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between the City of Centerville (hereinafter "Centerville"), and the Board of Health of the Montgomery County, Ohio, Combined General Health District, (hereinafter "Board of Health") under the following circumstances.

WHEREAS, a Board of Health and the legislative authority of a city may contract for the provision of health services pursuant to R.C. 3709.281, and

WHEREAS, Centerville desires to have the Board of Health furnish certain public health services within the corporate limits of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties that:

- 1. The Board of Health, through its agents, is hereby authorized to conduct a public health program in and render public health services to the City of Centerville. Such health program and services shall be substantially equivalent to the program and services performed elsewhere in Montgomery County by the Board of Health.
- 2. In consideration of the provision of such public health services by the Board of Health, Centerville shall pay to the Board of Health the sum of Thirty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Eight Dollars (\$39,848), plus the amount of reimbursement received from the State Treasurer and commonly known as the state subsidy to local public health; office supplies; office facilities; and other considerations as mutually agreed. (Attachment A).
- 3. The Board of Health shall periodically submit to Centerville a statement of services in carrying-out the provisions of the Agreement.
- 4. This Agreement shall be in effect from January 1, 1980, through December 31, 1980. This Agreement may be terminated with six (6) months written notice.

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between the City of Centerville, Ohio (hereinafter "Centerville"), and the Board of Health of the Montgomery County Ohio, Combined General Health District (hereinafter "Board of Health"), under the following circumstances.

WHEREAS, a Board of Health and the legislative authority of a city may contract for health services purusant to R.C. 3709.281, and

WHEREAS, Centerville desires to have the Board of Health furnsih certain housing services within the corporate limits of the city;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties that:

- 1. The Board of Health, through its agents, is hereby authorized to enforce the Montgomery County, Ohio, General Health District Housing Regulations (hereinafter the "Housing Regulations"), within the corporate limits of the City of Centerville, Ohio. Such right of enforcement shall be subject to the conditions enumerated in this Agreement.
- 2. Enforcement of the Housing Regulations by the Board of Health shall be on a "complaint basis" only. The Board of Health or its agents shall take no action whatsoever in enforcing the Housing Regulations without the prior approval of an authorized representative of Centerville.
- 3. In consideration of the performance of such housing enforcement services by the Board of Health, Centerville shall reimburse the Board of Health at a rate of Fifteen Dollars (\$15) per man-hour.
- 4. The Board of Health shall periodically render a statement of expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of this Agreement.
- 5. This Agreement may be terminated by Centerville or the Board of Health upon six months written notice to the other party.
- This Agreement shall be in full force and effect upon its execution by the parties herego.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties that the City of Centerville shall pay One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) as its pro-rated share for the cost of this program, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health, the City of Dayton and the United Way are desirous of maintaining a service known as the Dayton Free Clinic and Counseling Service, (hereinafter "Free Clinic") which provides counseling and referral services to youths between the ages of thirteen and nineteen, and

- The Board of Health hereby agrees to operate and maintain the Free Clinic for so long as the present budget will permit.
- 2. In consideration of the continued operation and maintenance of the Free Clinic, Centerville shall pay Fourteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,400) as its pro-rated share for the cost of this service.
- 3. The Board of Health shall periodically submit to Centerville a statement of services incurred in carrying-out the provisions of this Agreement.
- 4. This Agreement shall be in effect from January 1, 1980, through December 31, 1980. This Agreement may be terminated with six (6) months written notice.
