A RESOLUTION CREATING A SPECIAL FUND AND CONDITIONS.


WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to continue the excellent relationship existing between the Washington Township Trustees and Council resulting from their mutual cooperation in recognizing the need for and working toward a common government for our common community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE THAT:


Section 1. If the petition filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County by The Lutheran Social Service of the Miami Valley for the annexation of Bethany Lutheran Village to the City of Centerville receives approval, any taxes received by the City of Centerville which but for the annexation would have gone to Washington Township, shall be placed in a special fund for a period of one year from the effective date of the annexation.

Section 2. At the end of the one year period, the funds shall be transferred to the general fund of a new government formed by Washington Township and the City of Centerville or, in the absence of such new government being formed, shall be transferred to the general fund of the City of Centerville.


