

RESOLUTION NO. 18-79  
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Wova Wcke ON THE 11th DAY  
OF June, 1979.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A PUBLIC DISASTER AND AUTHORIZING  
THE PURCHASE OF ONE GARBAGE REFUSE PACKER TRUCK.

WHEREAS, on June 4, 1979 at 1:15 PM, a City owned refuse packer  
truck was destroyed by fire causing a disruption in waste collection service;  
and

WHEREAS, Section 7.07 of the Centerville Charter provides that in  
cases of public disaster, declared by resolution approved by at least five  
(5) members of Council, purchases and contractual services may be made  
without competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby declares a public disaster to be  
imminent by virtue of the fact that the City will be unable to provide  
adequate refuse collection service thus endangering life and health because  
of the inability to remove household refuse in a timely manner.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The Council, by a vote of at least five of its members,  
hereby declares the existance of a public disaster, pursuant to Section 7.07  
of the Centerville Charter, necessitating the purchase of one garbage refuse  
packer truck without competitive bidding.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to  
purchase one 1971 Mack truck with a Dempster 20 yard packer unit without  
competitive bidding for the lowest price obtainable.
