DAY OF October, 1979.

A RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE'S
COMMITMENT TO EQUAL EMPLOYMENT AND FAIR HOUSING
OPPORTUNITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville recognizes and acknowledges that we share the problems of and the responsibility for addressing non-jurisdictional community-wide issues; especially issues such as urban sprawl, taxation, and housing opportunity; and, in particular, how such issues impact the health and vitality of the area's center city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has consistently supported equal employment opportunities and fair housing opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


- and
1. A reaffirmation of Centerville's local Fair Housing Ordinance;
 2. A reaffirmation of Centerville's Affirmative Action Plan; and
 3. To continue support of the area's Housing Assistance Plan; and
 4. That we commit to soliciting all businesses located in Centerville within a one (1) mile radius of I-675 interchanges in the City to become signators to affirmative action hiring plans with goals of 10% minority hiring; and
 5. That we commit to cooperate and strive to work for the creation of a regional tax sharing formula which will be utilized for agreed upon areawide community needs; and
 6. That we commit to commence similar agreements with any and all other Miami Valley communities that are willing to share this areawide approach to common problems and their solution.
