

RESOLUTION NO. 52-79
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Leonard Stubbs ON THE 19th
DAY OF November, 1979.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE 1979 BUDGET COMMISSION'S
ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF DISTRIBUTING LOCAL GOVERNMENT
FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville is a participant in Local
Government Funds distributed by the Montgomery County Budget Commission,
and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Budget Commission has presented to
the City of Centerville an alternate method of distribution for Local
Government Funds, to-wit:

1. The Montgomery County Budget Commission shall deduct
the Board of Health allocation, now paid by the Townships
and Villages, from the Local Government Fund.
2. The Budget Commission shall use the average of the last two
(2) years Local Government allocation as the new minimum
and update same annually.
3. The amount certified by the state, over and above the
minimum allocation, is to be distributed in the same
proportion as the percentage of increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The City of Centerville, Ohio, hereby accepts the
alternative method of distribution proposed by the 1979 Montgomery County
Budget Commission, commencing with the 1980 allocation and continuing for
an indefinite period of time.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of the Council of the City of Centerville,
Ohio is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Montgomery
County Auditor.
