RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE 208 WATER QUALITY
MANAGEMENT PLAN DEVELOPED BY THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL
PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS a 208 Water Quality Management Plan ("Plan") has been developed by the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission, the areawide water quality planning agency, for the Miami Valley Region (the "Region"), pursuant to Section 208 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended by the Clean Water Act of 1977, P.L. 95-217 (the "Act"), and satisfies the criteria contained in the Act and in the guidelines issued by the United States Environmental Protection Agency in respect thereof, including those relating to designation of the problem area ("area") for which the Plan has been developed; and

WHEREAS federal regulations require, among other things, that the affected general purpose units of local government within the area must show their intent, through formally adopted resolutions, to join together in the planning process to support and utilize a plan which will result in a coordinated waste treatment system for the area; and

WHEREAS such waste treatment management system is a necessary and significant process to control present point and non-point sources of water pollution and to guide development in the area which may affect water quality, in order to prevent, abate and solve existing and potential substantial water quality control problems; and

WHEREAS this adopting body is a unit of local government or a representative organization with elected officials or their designee from local government (s) and is capable of implementing parts of the Plan for the Region;

NOW THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Centerville, recognizing that the Region has substantial water quality problems, supports the Plan and areawide management of such problems thereunder.

SECTION 2. That the Council of the City of Centerville intends to join with affected general purpose units of local government and other bodies and agencies within the Region to support and utilize the Plan, which will result in a coordinated waste treatment management system for the Region.

SECTION 3. That the Council of the City of Centerville accepts designation as a management agency to the extent (if any) provided in the Plan and supports and will implement the Plan for the Region.

SECTION 4. It is further resolved that all proposals for grants for construction of publicly owned treatment works within the boundaries of the Region will be reviewed for consistency with the approved Plan and will be made by the designated management agency or agencies.
